Subject: Enhancements to Transthoracic Echo (TTE) Guideline

NIA has enhanced our Transthoracic Echocardiography (TTE) clinical guideline to highlight clinical indications geared to cover the pediatric population. The change to list pediatric indications in a separate section was reviewed and approved by our Clinical Guideline Committee Task Force as well as external pediatric cardiologists. References were also added to support the pediatric clinical indications.
